The Georgetown Fire Station Parking Lot LID project continues to be recognized as a signature project for CDP and the City of Georgetown by being selected as the APWA Kentucky Chapter Environmental Project of the Year. This DOW 319(h) grant funded project demonstrated the design, installation, and function of numerous Low Impact water quality and quantity Best Management Practices through field days, a Facebook page, and presentations at seminars and conferences in KY and surrounding states. The completed site continues to serve as an educational resource for Georgetown and other interested communities and agencies through the use of self guided interpretive signage displayed at the site.
