CDP collaborated with Ned Crankshaw, landscape architect, to prepare an urban park master plan for the renaissance city of Berea. The proposed park transformed an abandoned corner lot into a vibrant place of gathering and activity to function as the town center. The plan incorporates open space for gatherings and events, an arbor to provide shade and visual enclosure, a “green” fountain to provide seasonal color and function as a focal point for the park, and landscape plantings to define the space without separating the park from the fabric of the community.
