CDP is preparing construction documents to upgrade an existing storm sewer system, which currently consists of roadside swales and dry wells. The improvements will improve drainage and remove localized flooding in the area. A closed conduit system will be installed that extends to known flood prone areas and will also connect the network of dry wells, ultimately discharging through a new outfall on an unnamed tributary of the Little Miami River. Approximately 2,609 feet of pipe (12'-36") will be laid along roadways, 25 new inlets installed, and the road over much of the project limits will be completely resurfaced. The system design will accommodate future phases that will tie into the infrastructure.
