CDP Engineers assisted the City of Berea with the design of roadway improvements for Glades Road, an urban arterial highway crossing the northern section of Berea. This work was conducted in three separate phases to cover the total 1.5 mile length.

Phase I involved intersection improvements at the east end, at KY 1016. This 5-way intersection requires improvements to reduce congestion and improve safety.

The second phase is from the limits of Phase I to US 25, a distance of approximately 0.5 mile. Phase 3 extends from Phase 2 to KY 595, a distance of approximately 0.8 mile.

The Glades Road project included the following elements:



project components

- Designs for a three-lane typical section to provide a continuous left turn lane.
- Geometric designs to minimize impacts on adjacent properties.
- Drainage designs, including storm sewers, open channels, and a box culvert.
- Preparation of detailed construction plans and specifications.
- Right of way plans.
- Striping plans.
- Bidding and construction administration services.
